Various industrial applications are used to exploit holographic technology for quality control in production and fracture testing, such as non-destructive holographic controls. Technology flexibility makes other industrial design applications inevitable. Holograms or "Heads-up" displays are used in military and civilized aircraft. Holograms provide critical information pilots in which to look through the cockpit windows. Technology has found a home in the least technological world, too. In an attempt to transmit images and messages not possible with traditional media, artists "explore" 3-D space and pure light through holography. But medical professionals are the most likely first improved hologram users. Today's radiograph methods of magnetic resonance and Cat-Scan cameras collect 3-D data, but offers holography a way to examine those images in a complete 3-D format.
