Firefox, Chrome and Internet Explorer do not have that button, but allow you to install add-ons that pages forward. These add-ons are free, small and installable in a few minutes. You also have the ability to save a web page on your hard drive and send it manually as an attachment. This process takes more time than one add-on, but you do not need to install anything to hide it. Each browser has a rescue function that you can use to save the current web page to your hard drive in different formats. Click the browser menu button and then click "Save page" if you use Firefox. Navigate to the desired folder and type a name for the file in the file name text box. Give a significant name so you can find it again when you are ready to email it. Click the "Save as type" drop-down menu and select "webpage, complete (htm,html)" if you use Firefox or IE. If you use Chrome, click "webpage, complete." click save, and the browser saves all the files needed to rebuild the web page. Start file explorer and go to the folder where you saved the page. You will see a subfolder that has the same name typed in the text box "Save as." that folder contains all the files needed to rebuild the web page. Right-click the mouse on "send to" followed by "zipped folder (zipped)" file explorer compresses folder files and stores them in a new zip folder that has the same name. This type of folder is compressed (zipped) folder, you will see it in the file explorer type column. Drag the saved HTML file into the zip folder and file explorer stores a copy of the HTML file in that folder. When you're finished, your new zip folder contains the HTML web page and all the files you need for a browser. Compose a new email in your email client and add the Zip folder as an attachment. When the recipient receives the folder, he can double-click it to unlock the folder and view its content. Alternatively, you can click on "Web Page, HTML Only (.htm, html) when you select an option from the " Save As Type "drop-down menu. However, the recipient may not see the same web page than you saw why this option does not store all the files needed to recreate the web page. No zip is required if you choose "Web Page, HTML Only" because the browser saves a single HTML file that you can send as Attachment. Several developers have created Firefox Add-Ons - as the Web Email - which you can use to save browser pages and send them quickly. This add-in also helps you to e-mail Web pages that are password-protected or require registration. The email This additional component requires a different approach by sending an email to the recipients a link to the page you are viewing. The email also contains the title of the page and any text you've highlighted while viewing you are visual during the page. Google Chrome calls its additional components extensions. The Chrome Send Page extension is similar to Firefox email this add-on. After installing Submit page, right-click the current web page and select "Send this page". The default e-mail client opens and consists of a message containing a link to the page. Install the Fireshot extension, and you can capture an image of a web page and send it via email. You also have the possibility to edit the image and add annotations before sending it as an e-mail. Add the Add to any add-on to IE and you can email interesting web pages and share them on sites like Facebook, Twitter and Reddit.
