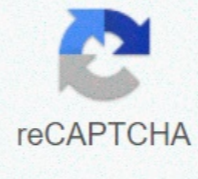

Alexa device settings

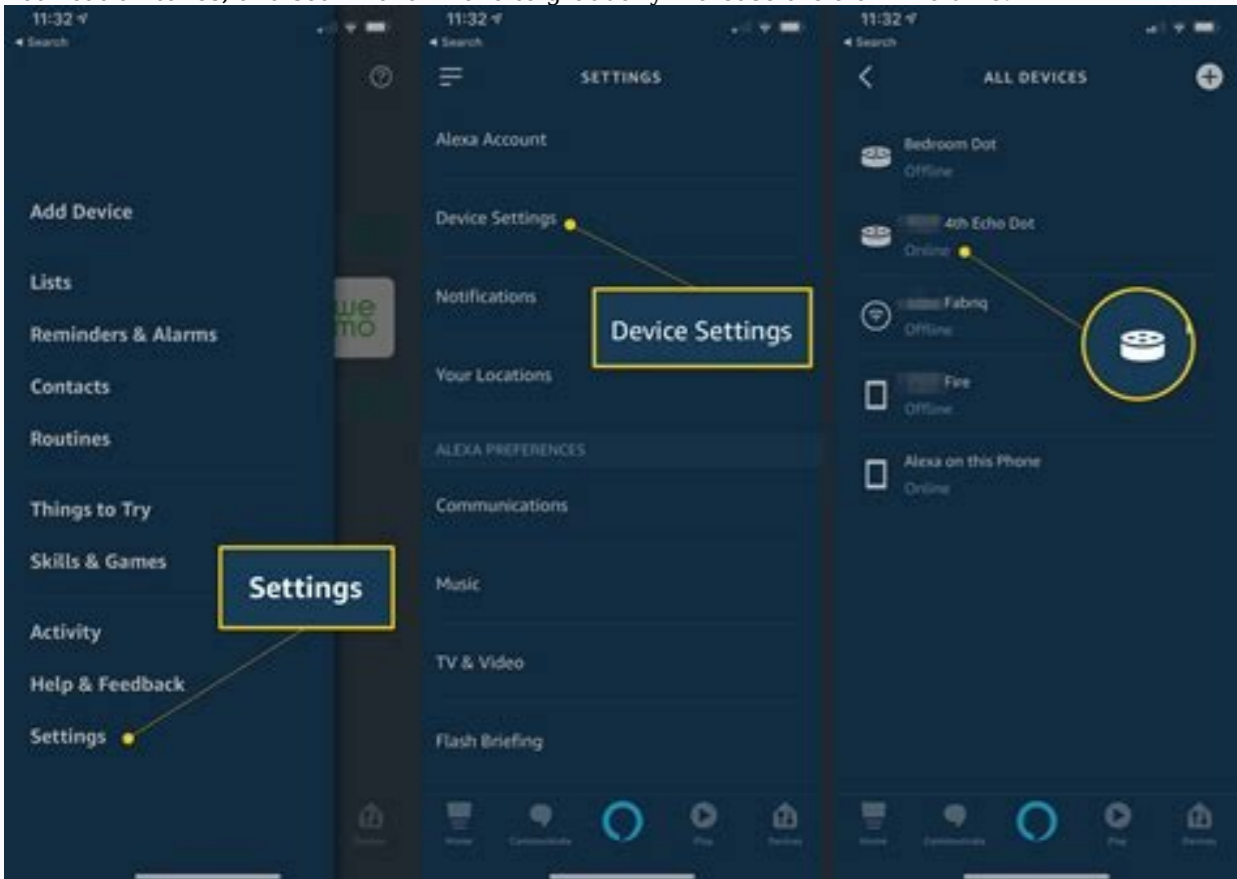
