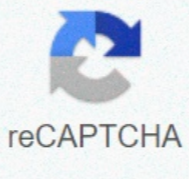

And after many of those great stops, the crowd sang "SOOUP" as a tribute to the numerous nicknames related to Campbell's soup. He joined the team in February 2020, only played two regular matches with a crowd for Leafs at the Scotiabank Arena before this season due to the pandemic COVID-19. He played in all three games until this season, having been forced to lose Thursday in relief of Petr Mrazek, who suffered an injury to the groin in his first game like Leaf. With Mrazek out for at least two weeks, Campbell is likely to start at least four of the next six Leaf matches. Campbell said it was the first time he heard the song "Soup". In Toronto Maple Fans of the leaves, Jack Campbell became known as a second premier, and now the first emergency option, after the loss of starting Frederik Andersen to a lower body injury. After the 2011-12 season, Campbell migrated with Stars AHL in Texas, dividing time on a Stars team who was involved in a network play. Mainly the split time with the former star SEL Christopher Nilstorp, Campbell has improved to a red-hot 12-2-2 beginning of the 2013-14 season, getting its first NHL beginning in the process, allowing 6 goals on 47 hits. After this however, Campbell struggled consistently, eventually getting demoted to ECHL Idaho Steelheads for parts of the next two seasons. While showing his potential once again, posting a record of 14-5 with a 1.68 GAA and four shutouts in 2015-16, it was not where the Stars expected Campbell to be less, and with the team now have a reliable tandem of Antti Niemi and Kari Lehtonen in goal, Campbell was traded to the Kings in 2016 offseason in exchange for AHL farm Nick Ebert. With former AHL appetizer Peter Budaj who has now been named as the Kings start after Quick's loss of wounds, Campbell assumed the mantel as AHL holder for the Kings AHL branch, Ontario Reign in 2016-17, posting a record of 31-15-0 with five shutouts as he finally began to show his starting potential. Since then, Campbell has slowly but surely caught the eye of ever more loyal NHL, culminating in his red-hot trend this season with the Maple Leafs. Throughout his career, Campbell has always shown glimpses of the potential that Stars have seen back in 2010, and as soon as he has earned his stripes as a reliable backup, he seems equally ready to take homework in Toronto.
