## How do i convert a doc file to docx

By Mara Shannon Converting a WMA (Windows Media audio) file to DOC (Microsoft Works) provides an easy way to read or search through an audio recording of speech without having to listen to or transcribe the entire recording. An easy program to convert speech to text is Wave to Text, which you can download and try for free. To use it, you must first convert the WMA file to WAV, then convert the completed text file to DOC. Download Wave to Text, extract the files and install the program. Open Media Convert, a free file conversion website. Click "Browse" and select your WMA file. Choose "WAVE form audio format (\*.wav)" under "Output format." Under "Advanced Settings," choose "Mono" for "Audio Channels" and "22050 Hz" for "Audio Sampling Rate." (If you convert the WMA file to WAV with another converter, make sure you can change the settings, or it might not work with Wave to Text.) Click "OK" to convert the file. When it's finished converting, click on the link to the converted file and save a copy to your computer. Open Wave to Text and click "Convert Wave to Text." Click "Add" to browse for and select your WAV file. Click "Open file(s)" to index the WAV file. Change the speech recognition accuracy and speed to your desired settings and click "Start" to convert. Click "Edit Text" on the Wave to Text toolbar. Click "Open" and select your WAV file. Edit the text. If you highlight a word and click "Start Edit," you can hear the word played to see if the program's transcription was correct. When you are done, click "Save as text" to save the transcribed text as a TXT (plain text) document. Open the TXT document in Microsoft Word or another word processing program that can write DOC files, such as Open Office. Go to "File->Save as." Under "Save as type," select "Microsoft Word (\*.doc)" and click "Save." While they all work best when the PDF file primarily contains text and each one is straightforward to use, the best method largely depends on your personal preference and the applications you're most comfortable using. Word, Adobe Acrobat, and even Google Docs feature an approach to convert PDF to DOCX. Instructions in this article apply to Word 2019, Word 2016, Word 2013, and Word for Microsoft 365. When a PDF file is mostly text, opening it within Microsoft Word will convert it to a DOCX file automatically. Once the file is converted, it may not correspond perfectly with the original PDF. For instance, page breaks and line breaks could be different. Within Microsoft Word, open the PDF file. A message alerts that Word will convert your PDF to an editable Word document. Select OK. If you select Don't Show This Message Again, Word will automatically convert any PDFs you open in the future. Once the file opens, you can edit, cut, copy, or format the text. Word will automatically save the file as a DOCX file in the default document location. Adobe and Microsoft Office play quite nicely together. In fact, it's possible to convert a PDF in Adobe Acrobat to a Word document, an Excel worksheet, or even a PowerPoint presentation file. Converting PDF files to Word documents and other formats is only available in premium versions of Adobe Acrobat. Open Adobe Acrobat DC.Select the PDF file, then select Open. Select Export in the left pane to expand the Adobe Export PDF menu. Select Microsoft Word (\*.docx) in the Convert to list. Select Convert. Sign in to your Adobe account if prompted.
