He was first staged on September 29, 1955, as a drama on the back of an act with a memorial of two second-tracks at Teatro Coronet on Broadway. Marco is quiet and thoughtful, possessing a noticable force, while Rodolfo is no longer conventional, with plans to make a song a song in the United States. Marco has a familia starving in Italy and plans to return after working illegally for several years, while Rodolfo intends to stay. Although Eddie, Beatrice and Catherine are at first excellent hostesses, cracks appear when Rodolfo and Catherine began to date. Eddie is convinced that Rodolfo is homosexual and is only expressing interest in Catherine so he can marry her and gain status as a legal citizen. He confronts Catherine with beliefs and she turns to Beatrice for her advice. Beatrice, beginning to realize Eddie's true feelings, says she should marry Rodolfo and leave. Meanwhile, Eddie turns to Alfieri, waiting for the help of the law. At the Alfieri tells him that the only resource he is to report Rodolfo and Marco as in irregular situation. Do not see any solutions to her problem, Eddie becomes more and more desperate and takes her anger in And when he teaches him the box, "accidentally" will hurt him. Marco reacts silently threatening Eddie, showing her forces holding a heavy chair above Eddie's head with a hand and "smiling with triumph." Act 2 a few months passed and Eddie reaches a rupture point when he discovers that Catherine and Rodolfo slept together and have the intention of getting married. Drinked, he kisses Catherine and then tries to prove that Rodolfo is gay suddenly and kissing him in love too. After a violent confrontation, Eddie orders Rodolfo to leave the apartment. Eddie visits Alfieri and insists that the kiss proved that Rodolfo is gay and that he is only getting married by Catherine for citizenship, but once again Alfieri says the law can not help. Out of despair, the immigration services of Eddie phones, but at noon Beatrice organized Marco and Rodolfo to move with two other undoubted immigrants in the apartment above. Eddie learns that Catherine and Rodolfo organized to get married within a week and about the two new immigrants that moved to the prime and, with anger and fear, it frantically urges Catherine and Beatrice to push them away. When immigration authorities arrive and hold Marco, Rodolfo, and the other other immigrants, Eddie pretends that prison comes as a complete surprise for him, but Beatrice and Marco vain through il. Marco spits on Eddie's face in front of everyone and accuses Eddie to kill his hungry children. Eddie tries to convince the neighborhood of his innocence, but they move away from him. Alfieri visits Marco and Rodolfo under custody, getting his release in the fiancée until his audience appears. Alfieri explains that Rodolfo will be able to stay once he married Catarina, but warns Marco that he will have to go back to Italy. Vingeful, Marco confronts Eddie publicly in his release, and Eddie turns with a knife, demanding that he remove his accusations and restore his honor. In the following, Eddie is stabbed with his own knife and dies, since his familia and tormented neighbors are around. When he witnesses Eddie's death, Alfieri shakes because he realizes that although he was wrong, something "pure pure" call him and he is full of admiration. But, he says to the public, establishing himself by means of measures, must be, and so he cries from Eddie with an alarm sensation in his own feelings.
